In a narrative citation, according to APA (2020), “the date appears in parentheses immediately after the author name” and the page or paragraph number follows the quotation (p. 263). The year goes with the author, not the page number. If the quotation was found on one . 5 page, “p.” goes before the page number. If it was on two pages, a “pp.” is used instead.
