Web(3) If the parents of minor children live apart during this proceeding, they shall assist their children in having contact with both parties, which is consistent with the habits of the family, personally, by telephone, and in writing. This provision shall not apply if and to the extent there is a prior, contradictory order of a judicial authority.

SF2.4: Share of births outside of marriage - OECD

Webnuptial/out-of-wedlock births, that is, where the child's parents are not registered as married to each other (or, for New Zealand, in a civil union with each other) at the time of birth. The "share of births outside of marriage" is calculated as the number of births to women whose legal marital status at the time of the birth
